



THE GOSPEL PROJECT JR. Unit 1 Lesson 3-Sin Entered the World

Date: Sunday March 15th, 2020 **Teachers:** Susan, Annika , Nijel D, Olivia B

Bible Passage: Genesis 3:1-24

Key Passage: 1 Corinthians 8:6

CIRCLE TIME: (volunteer with little ones,) (10 min)

Welcome kids, sitting on chairs in circle (Lead Teacher)

Review Rules:

One Mouth speaking at a time (Teacher points to mouths/kids point to their mouths)

Two Hands kept to myself (kids wiggle hands and keep them to themselves)

Two Feet kept to myself (kids cross legs)

Three Chances to Obey (1st. warning 2nd. remove from activity 3. call parent)

INTRO THE BIBLE STORY: (Susan)materials: (cut out the Faces printable(2X)Glue the pictures to a large sheet of construction paper. Cut out the second sheet of faces individually)

Last week we talked about how God made everything and God made people. God made people of every tribe and tongue. Let's try to match these faces. We have been learning how God created people, but this week we are going to hear about something God didn't create- sin. We are going to see how Sin entered the world.

THE BIBLE STORY (VIDEO) (Susan)

TEACH GOSPEL GEMS (use the laminated pic of Adam & Eve) **(Susan)**

We don't know what Adam and Eve looked like, the Bible doesn't have pictures, this is someone's drawing of them because they are white and they drew white people. Adam and Eve could have had black skin, brown skin, yellow skin- we don't know)

God made people to make choices.

Adam and Eve did not obey God's one rule.

God loves us even when we make wrong choices.

God sent Jesus because He loves us.

OBJECT LESSON 1 (Susan) materials (fruit from home)

God made everything. God loves people. God sent Jesus because He loves us.

Provide fake or real fruit for kids to touch. What was the one rule that God gave to Adam and Eve? You can eat from every tree in the garden except this one tree. The serpent tempted them and they trusted the Serpent over trusting God. They thought God was holding out on them, but God loved them and was protecting them.

DISMISS TODDLERS TO PLAY AREA, PRESCHOOLERS CAN DO THE FOLLOWING ACTIONS

OBJECT LESSON 2: *Where Is Adam & Eve?* (Annika) materials (Adam and Eve printable(in folder in laptop bag, Cut out simple tree shapes from construction paper to cover the figures. (construction paper in blue file bin OR large blue bin)

Ask the kids to come up and uncover the pictures. Adam and Eve were hiding from God, because they knew right away that they had wronged God. They felt so much shame for doing wrong, but they also felt like they were wrong and they couldn't make it better.

It would take Jesus coming and living a perfect life for us and dying on a cross for things to finally be better and God and man to be restored

OPTIONAL ACTIVITY: "Do What I Do" (Annika)

Play a simple action game. Perform a simple action (clap your hands) and invite kids to do it too.

Say: God made everything. He made people to love and obey Him. You obeyed me when you [action]. Adam and Eve disobeyed God and it would take Jesus totally obeying perfectly for us to be restored again to God.
